The **Cellar Foot** range is quoted as Lammershoek's 'project label' where 'we can push the boundaries in wine-making and work with unusual and interesting varieties'. And there is little doubt that Craig Hawkins has been doing just this. The wines of Lammershoek have changed dramatically since his arrival and these are South Africa's most likely answer to the 'natural wine' movement; wines of no recipe, low sulphur (sometimes none!) and often wacky flavours and aromas. They recently received heavy criticism by **Michel Chapoutier**, denouncing the winemakers as 'out-of-touch hippies making defective wines', quotes Decanter.

The Cellar Foot range is made in tiny quantities and they are indeed quite unique, but the wines are not out-of-touch. They are charactered, pure and stylish wines that are a complete must-have for any collector. We have included the **2010 Roulette Blanc** in the offer as we feel it's an absolute beauty; made in a similar oxidative style, it offers great value for money!

Lammershoek Cellar Foot Harslevelu 2011

This wine is made from a 0.7ha block of 42 year old vines planted here at Lammershoek by Pongrácz himself. The name refers to 'lime leaf', one of its major characteristics and it has a Hungarian heritage. The massive acidity is balanced by an oily texture and perfume. Quite rich, taut and fragrant, the palate is lengthy and mineral. It opened up well over two days, so it should age quite well!

Lammershoek Cellar Foot Mourvedre 2010

Made from 15 year old vines, mostly whole bunch and aged in old big barrels on its gross lees. Provençal herbs are the first to appear with a merry mix of cherries and berries riddling the nose. It is lifted with a touch of fennel and peking duck, leading to a rich and savoury palate. Quite structured and built for 5-8 years aging.

Lammershoek Cellar Foot Underwater Syrah 2011

4 barrels of syrah were submerged in a concrete water tank for aging (hence its name). It is the simpler of the three, offering more immediate drinking enjoyment. It's unbelievable pure and fruity with ample cherry and almost candy-like notes sewn up with ultra soft tannins. Drink it over the next few years.

Lammershoek Roulette Blanc 2010

While the 2009 was a Platter 5 Star, we feel the 2010 is superior with a finer texture and more freshness. It's a blend of a number of varieties but chenin and chardonnay make up the majority. Some beeswax, green apple, cinnamon and five spice lead to a long, structured and elegant palate. A serious mineral wine that punches well above its weight!
