



Good day Pinot lover

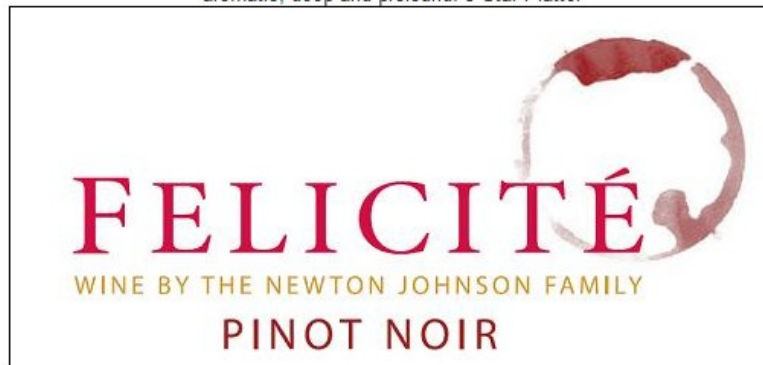

Their latest release, the **2010 Family Vineyards** is an absolute revelation; it's purity of fruit, delicacy and balance reminds one of the pleasures found only in the Côte d'Or. The Platter tasters seem to agree with its 3rd consecutive **5 star** rating. But for a pinot that you can literally drink every day, there is **no better value** (anywhere?) than its little sister, the **Félicité 2011**. Due to high demand and low volumes it's unfortunately all allocated to the on-trade. NEWTON JOHNSON FELICITE PINOT NOIR 2011 - R390/6

Sourced from various vineyards including some in Elgin and the Upper Hemel-en-Aarde, this wine is a quintessential expression of red-berry pinot fruit with savoury nuances in an aromatic, medium body. Exceptionally balanced and embarrassingly drinkable.
